Understand AI

- Write "The cat sat on the..." and have kids finish it, then explain that is what AI does
- Play the autocomplete game: tap predicted words 20 times on a phone keyboard
- Sort pictures into groups (animals vs vehicles) then explain AI does the same
- Play "bot or not": read two stories one human one AI and guess which
- Ask an AI to draw a "doctor" and a "nurse" and discuss the bias
- Discuss AI ethics at dinner: "If AI writes an essay who gets the grade?"

Use AI Wisely

- Use a chatbot with supervision and compare vague vs specific prompts
- Ask AI factual questions and verify answers with real sources
- Type a bad prompt see the mediocre result then upgrade it together

Media Literacy

- Play "spot the ad" while watching TV together
- Do a reverse image search on a dramatic photo
- Pick a claim your child heard and trace it back to its original source
- Watch commercials together and ask: what are they selling what feeling are they creating
- Show a mix of real and AI-generated photos and see if kids can tell
- Use the "three-source rule" before believing any interesting claim

- Use AI as a brainstorming partner for stories or video projects
- After every AI use check at least one claim against a real source
- Ask AI facts about your home country then fact-check every one
