Explore & Discover

- Let kids be the navigator: hand them the map
- Give each kid a small daily budget in local currency
- Order food in the local language at a shop or restaurant
- Visit a local museum nature center or workshop
- Hold a family meeting each evening: what surprised you
- Take a cooking class with a local family
- Join a local sports group in a new country
- Walk your downtown asking "what is the oldest thing here?"

Go Deep

- Spend a full week researching something that sparked curiosity
- Pick one "go deep" day per week: spend all day at one site
- Return to favorite spots and compare visits over time
- Trace your family's immigration story on a world map

Document & Create

- Start a daily travel journal (notebook photo journal or app)
- Write and record an original song about a travel experience
- Create a blog post with research writing and photos
- Make a poster about a country: wildlife geography and culture
- Film a day-in-the-life video at each new place
- Photograph five things that are different from home
- Draw a map of your route from memory

- Keep a "question jar" notebook of every question asked during the day
- Cook a meal from your family's heritage country
- Interview a local person about their daily life
